2019 STATE PRIORITIES

Expand regional public and private partnerships in health sciences, healthcare and human services:

In early 2018, Radford University joined with Carilion Clinic and Jefferson College of Health Sciences to announce a groundbreaking partnership in order to increase the number of healthcare graduates, save students time and money, provide enhanced access to ongoing research and further grow the healthcare pipeline across the Commonwealth.

- **\$1.7 million** in additional funding for operating support.

Enhance academic delivery and interdisciplinary engagement by replacing aging infrastructure:

Radford University requests **\$95 million** to modernize academic space, specifically the replacement of aging and deteriorating infrastructure with the Center for Adaptive Innovation and Creativity.

Increase access and opportunity for all Virginians:

Radford University requests **\$1.5 million** to serve current and future student populations from the Commonwealth and address critical workforce development needs throughout the region.

- **\$1.1 million** in additional funding for need-based financial aid for low- and middle-income students.
- **\$210,106** in new funding to establish the Office of Adult, Corporate and Community Education Services (ACCESS), which would serve as a central hub for advanced adult learning and professional development in Southwest Virginia.
- **\$230,276** in new funding to establish an Appalachian Community Outreach Institute (centered in Abingdon) to improve the health, vitality and economic sustainability of Southwest Virginia communities.

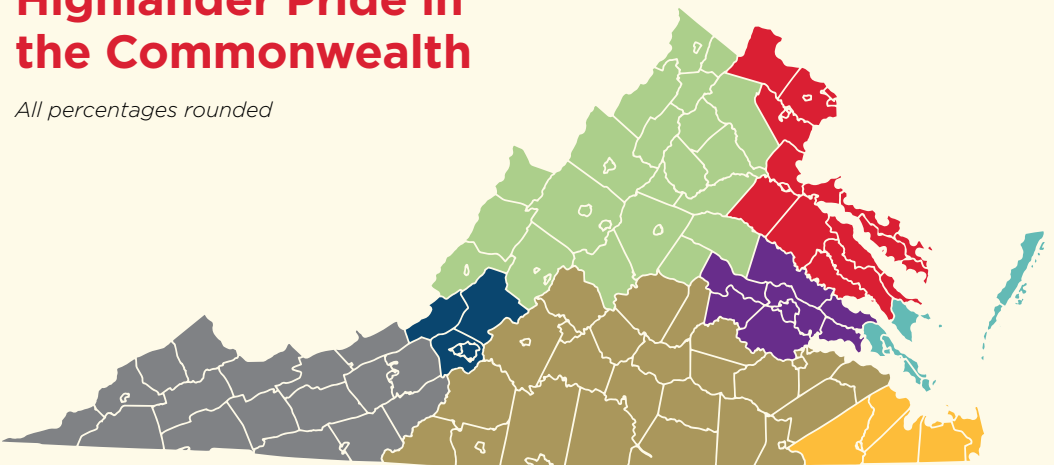
