

GLOBAL STUDY OPPORTUNITIES

At UNC Kenan-Flagler, our many unique experiential global opportunities will give you a chance to witness firsthand how business is conducted in international markets and shape your perspective of the world around you.

Global Immersion Electives (GIEs)

In our Global Immersion Electives, you'll study a world culture and economy by analyzing current business issues and learning how business is conducted abroad. Culminating in an intensive in-country immersion, you'll meet with business leaders, engage in unique cultural experiences, interact with local communities and develop key global competencies.

Doing Business In (DBI)

We offer short elective courses that give you an opportunity to study abroad and explore another culture. Courses typically last one to two weeks and include class sessions and/or cultural visits at one of our MBA exchange partner schools around the world.


CHAPEL HILL
